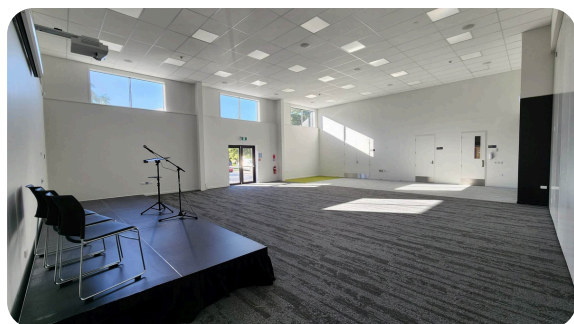

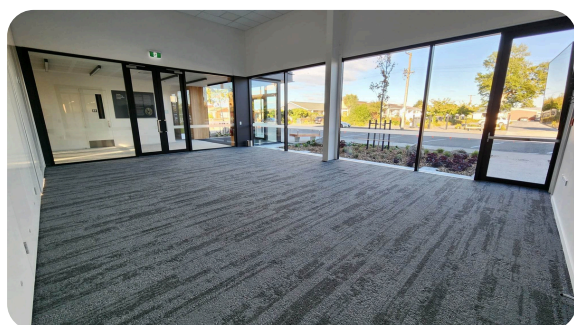
SETUP TYPES

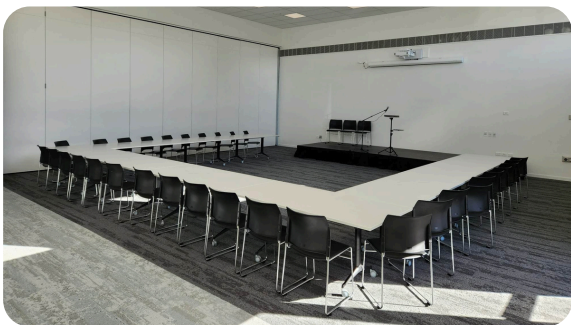
Ōtamatea and Waimeha

Theatre style is made up of rows of chairs facing the front of the room, usually with an aisle in the middle.

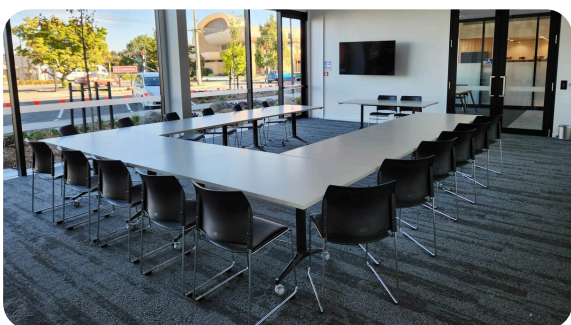
This setup is perfect for presentations, public speaking events or information sessions.

Both Ōtamatea and Waimeha can be combined into one large space to use for theatre style, due to the moveable divider wall separating them.

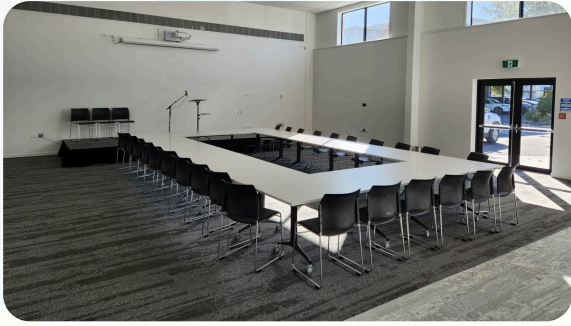


Waimeha

This shape is great for collaborative meetings, training sessions and presentations.

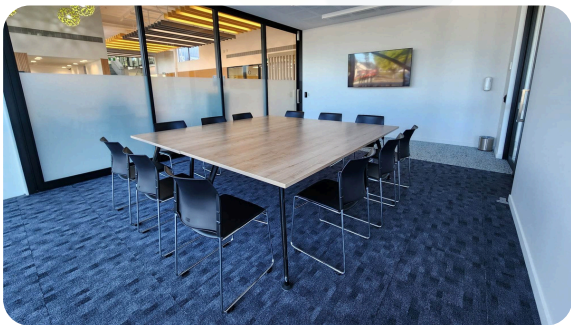

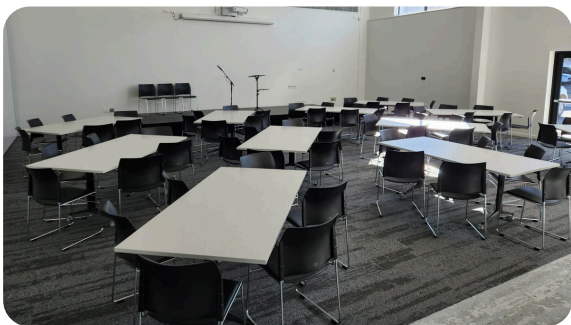
Waikākahi

Boardroom style is available in all rooms, with this being the permanent setup style in Waikākahi.

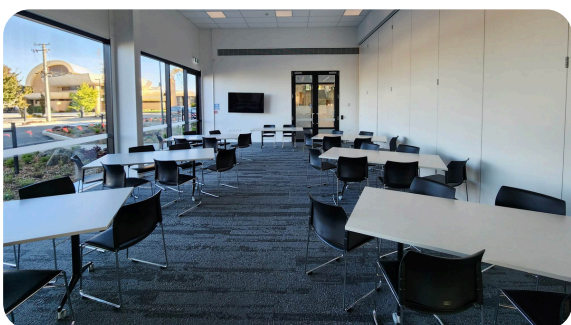
In Ōtamatea or Waimeha, the table can either be hollow (image 1) or solid (image 2). The default setup will be solid unless otherwise requested.

This setup is ideal for formal meetings or even private dinner functions.
